Description

Headband for a young, unmarried woman; center detail is composed of a fuchsia weave (cotton threads) with gold-colored, metal thread embroidery of forms (composition

unknown); embroidery is accented with gold-colored metal sequins. Bottom edge is trimmed with off-white, bobbin lace. Backed with white linen. Overall long, rectangular-shape with the center section having a curved bottom edge and the ties corners are rounded; ties of off-white linen are tuck pleated to fit ends of center section; ties are trimmed with 0.5", off-white, cotton thread, bobbin lace; ties extend 11.375" on either side Inscriptions: Label on back, right edge: "318" "Of a 1810-1820 style of Mladobole-Slavske"-Dr. J.
