Cloth (cotton, ?); leather; metal; glass; wood; reed; rhinestone

Description

Women's shoe; burgundy velvet shoe (called Butky) with leather sole, stacked wood heel, rubber heel cap, for woman's Czech Kroj; embroidered with gold-colored wire in floral design (at toe and heel); at top, toe-circular rhinestone surrounded by overlapping stitches; also adorned with gold-colored sequins and opaque, glass seed beads; square cut toe; cloth upper and insole; seam of upper located at arch area both sides; insole is an insert (original?) with woven reed base, white cotton top and dyello bias tape edge. inside upper lined with an olive/tan cotton canvas twill. self-edged opening; lacquered heel ---- "Shoes would have been worn for special events. Shoes are modeled after c. 1800-1839 wedding shoes of Central Bohemia"-Dr. Langhammerova 5/16/97 ---- *See "Reconstruction of 1st half of 19th Century" Dr. J.
