## Description

Batik apron; navy with white geometric patterns printed upon it; patterns alternate between vertical rows of rounded diamond shapes and rows of tiny circles that form a criss-cross pattern (the latter is in sections that are roughly one inch in width); three lines of white embroidery go around sides and bottom; white lace is also on sides and bottom; plain navy waistband; black ties at waist for closure; large rectangular section of embroidery at center top, just under waistband; section is made up of three lines of floral embroidery with solid lines sewn in between and a floral border all around; the embroidery is very colorful (yellow, orange, pink, green and white - all bright

colors); yellow ribbon with red, dark blue, white and green floral designs goes down front of apron (in the center); apron is pleated under embroidered section
