Description

Jacket from a World War II dress uniform; four gold buttons down right side of front opening with corresponding holes on the other side; four short gold bands at each cuff, as well as a black band that goes around each cuff; a pocket on each side at the bottom and one on each side at the top (all have flaps for closure, the top pockets have one gold button each); a gold pin is on each lapel with another one above (letters); three pins are on each shoulder; the first pin is an eagle, the second

is a seal, and the third is a circle; a colorful triangular patch is sewn at the top of each sleeve; gold braids hang from the right shoulder ---- worn by donor's husband, Adolf C. Topinka ---- Many elements (pins, etc.) removed during restoration and now numbered 1999.81.2a-h ----
