

# Basic Detail Report

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## Dress

### Date

1950-1990

### Medium

wool, velvet, linen, cotton

### Description

Part of a woman's wedding kroj; black pleated skirt with blue pokadots and light blue stitching across hem and mirrored roughly four inches above; the waistband is a narrow navy strip with light blue circular designs; the bodice of the dress is white wool with burgundy, light green, rust and gold ribbons in geometric designs; the green ribbon has a pattern of circles woven together in a chain; each circle has a rust colored center with gold threading around it; within the gold threading are silver accents; burgundy velvet is between each of these ribbon designs; this extends up and over wide straps to the back of the bodice; a simple ribbon of the green, gold and rust design extends around the bodice, just under the arms and around to the back; two white ties are at the back opening of the bodice for closure; two thick multi-colored ties are at the waistband for closure; the back of the skirt is made up of three different fabrics; the bottom is that of the front, next is a navy fabric with light blue floral patterns, a green and blue plaid fabric finishes out the top of the skirt and meets the waistband; the back of the skirt is not pleated.
