White square handkerchief (embroidery cloth) with embroidery and cross stitching throughout entire front surface; green, orange, red, yellow and blue star embroidered in middle of handkerchief; star has a brown cross-stitched square in its middle with a wide orange square around it; the star is outlined in yellow embroidery with a brown cross-stitched border around its most outer

edge; four cross-stitched lines begin in between the starpoints at each corner of the fabric and extend outward toward each corner; at the end of each line is a cross-stitched design; embroidered ribbons are on either side of each cross-stitched line; the upper left corner has red and yellow ribbons and its opposite corner has the same; the upper right corner has green and yellow ribbons with its mirror image in the opposite corner; in between each cross-stitched line and embroidered ribbons is a red cross-stitched geometric design; all of the edges of the handkerchief have brown edging with an orange embroidered pattern just inside that; part of a woman's kroj ---- Cicmany, Slovakia; purchased from Anna Blahusiak in the United States, active in Sokol work
