Part of woman's kroj; simple white blouse with gathered neck and sleeves; very small white cords tie at throat; ends of sleeves have a smocked section that is embroidered with blue geometric patterns and the ends of the cuffs are sewn with blue thread; section of sleeve where it meets the back of the blouse is stitched in blue
