Description

Part of a Svidník kroj; white shirt with large puffed sleeves; narrow band of red and black cross-stitching around collar and a third of the way down the front; stitching down front is in a vertical rectangular shape with roughly an inch of white material in its middle; the collar is like a dress shirt collar; five lines of similar cross-stitching are at each cuff; four silver snaps go down the front of the shirt (beginning at the collar and going down); small pieces of elastic are sewn in the cuffs. off-white pants with a black band that goes up each pantleg to the waistband; black bands are at the pants opening; two white buttons close the pants; a white elastic loop is at the bottom of each pantleg. black vest with wide red fabric on bottom, collar and front opening; this red fabric has black embroidery (running chain stitches) throughout in geometric designs; silver studs go down each side of the front opening with red bands and white and red

embroidery extending from the studs toward each sleeve; each of these has a stud on the side nearest the sleeve as well; two white buttons are at the collar with a white piece of elastic that attaches to each one; the vest back has blue, white, yellow, red and green embroidery in floral and geometric patterns in three lines; one line is down the middle of the back with another on each side; the side embroidery lines arch inward; a line of studs in on either side of the center embroidery line. Svidník, Slovakia; donors purchased about 30 kroje in the 1970's and 1980's while members of a traveling dance troupe
