Parts of a woman's Moravian kroj; red wool pleated skirt with three horizontal rows of embroidered flowers; flowers are white with purple centers, and have green and yellow leaves; waistband is embroidered red with silver metallic trim; skirt lined with white gauze; white thread sewn and tied in skirt to hold pleats in place Orangish-red silk vest with blue brocade inserts; back has gold sequins and metallic trim and three round orange and gold shapes; front has six gold and white floral buttons and gold metallic trim Dark blue apron with off-white bobbin lace that has red and green sections; embroidered in multicolored floral patterns; donor states 1914 and the initials "T" and "M" are embroidered into pattern, but SK did not see them White collar with black and white scalloped lace on three sides; black embroidery with some white on white; much cutwork; lined with pink fabric; pink, blue and green fabric pieces applied so that these colors

peek through openwork embroidery Off-white sash with pink and blue flowers and green leaves embroidered on it; edges have been cut with pinking shears White cap with dark red embroidered flowers; pink ribbons; sequins and lace trim overall; initials "MS" embroidered at top White cotton blouse with black lace at cuffs; black embroidery and cutwork at sleeves; cuffs lined with pink fabric that peeks through openwork; top of cuffs have white and black embroidered ribbon ties
