### Description

Parts of girl's kroj; white blouse with orange embroidery and cutout work on each pufffed sleeve, each cuff and down front opening; orange bobbin lace collar; gathered at neck and at tops of sleeves; made in Piest'any style Cream silk sash with floral embroidery; flowers are purple, red and dark red; leaves and stems are light green and white Navy apron with white bobbin lace around bottom; gold rick rack between lace and bottom of apron; white floral embroidery stitched just above rick rack; narrow white stitching down center of apron; ties for closure; gathered at waist; heavily pleated just under waist to

create more volume; two folds sewn into apron just under pleats White skirt with pink floral print; five folds sewn into skirt, horizontally all around middle of skirt; two narrow lace bands sewn beneath these and at bottom of skirt; lace bands do stop before getting to front of skirt; gathered at waist
