Description

Parts of a Slovak kroj; off-white blouse in woven fabric; long sleeves; gathered neckline and cuffs; red, dark green, and ecru collar, also woven with scalloped edges; cuffs finished in the same colors; small panel of floral embroidery at the top of each sleeve; embroidery is in bright orange, yellow, and grey-blue threading Red wool vest; striped, woven and gold machine embroidered ribbons decorate front and back; striped are in red, green, gold, white, and blue; ribbons are sewn onto front in a vertical design and rick rack style on back Off-white or cream woven fabric skirt; tightly pleated; front not pleated; pocket on front in woven ecru fabric Very dark navy apron covered with a white batik floral pattern; off-white waistband; striped, woven ties A cap made of an off-white, woven fabric; covered with red, dark green, and ecru yarn in both floral and geometric designs; thin yarn in the same colors frames the face; bottom has a white ribbon drawstring to secure around head Thick headband with twill tie sewn to each end; to be worn with the cap, gives it shape
