Description

tall plastic doll with synthetic hair and blue eyes that open and close; dressed in kroj from Uherské Hradiště; red headscarf with floral print; off-white blouse with large, puffed and pleated sleeves; both sleeves have four inch long lace cuffs with a black criss-cross design embroidered around the tops; each also has a long bow of white machine embroidered ribbon with a red, blue and green floral pattern; lace collar and jabot are also decorated with black and gold geometric embroidery, as are the shoulders of the blouse; black, pleated skirt with orange embroidery around the waistline; green and white floral brocade apron with silver sequins and beads flowers one and a half inches above its hemline; white sash with

machine embroidered floral designs in red and green threading; sash ends are decorated with the same sequins and beaded flowers; white petticoat with lace trim and matching bloomers; pink socks and white shoes (probably original to the doll, but not the kroj); tag attached to left arm reads, "#24-2 Sweet Sue in the Festive Costume for Uherské Hradiště in Czechoslovakia. Costume was made in Czechoslovakia. Jack Dobbs brought costume from Czechoslovakia. Lad and his mother were born in Zlechov, which is about 6 or 7 miles away from Uherské Hradiště." Second tag reads, "#24-2 Sweet Sue all hard plastic walker by American Character" on both sides
