Description

carved flute; six holes evenly spaced up from its bottom; in between each one is oval-shaped carving; a line of circular cuts that resemble the letter C runs around the flute just above the top hole, the top of the flute itself, and roughly half way in between the two; a flower resembling a daisy carved in between the C lines; small heart cut into wood beneath the top of the flute, along with the blow hole
